Numbers in the New Testament

John 3:14 – The Lord Jesus referring to the brazen serpent (Num 21)

I Cor 10:8-13 – Paul reminds believers of what happened to the nation of Israel in the wilderness; application to the assembly

• 2 Pet 2:15; Jude 11; Rev 2:14 – references to the character of Balaam

 Heb 9:13-14 – Contrast of the red heifer (Num 19) with the sacrifice of Christ
