How was the ark built?

- V15 Dimensions of the ark (approximate)
- 1 Cubit = About 18 inches
- 300 Cubits Long = 425 feet
- 50 Cubits Wide = 75 feet
- 30 Cubits Tall = 45 feet high



Cargo capacity = 20,000 tons = 522 railroad cars How did Noah find all the animals and how did everyone fit?




