HOLINESS DEFINED MORALITY ► RIGHTEOUS AND JUST

Lev. 19

- V2: The basis for the laws is God's holiness
- V3: Reverence parents
- V9-10: Caring for strangers and the needy
- V11-12: Acting with integrity toward others
- V13-14, 18: Being kind and loving toward others
- V15-16, 35-36: Being just and fair

| Pet. 1-3

- 1:14-15: Be holy in all your behavior
- 1:22: Have a sincere love of the brethren
- 2:1-3: Put aside malice, deceit, hypocrisy, envy, slander
- 2:12: Uphold excellent behavior
- 2:13, 18: Submit to governments and masters
- 2:24: Die to sin and live to righteousness
- 3:1,7: Spouses treat each other the right way
- 3:8-12: Summing it up

Without Blemish

Lev. 1:3 | 1 Pet. 1:19

- Animal had to be without defect
- Jesus was the sinless spotless lamb of God

Transference

Lev 1:4 | 1 Pet. 2:24

Person laid their hand on the animal's head

Jesus bore our sins in His body

Blood Shed

Lev. 17:11 | Eph. 1:7

- The life of the animal and atones for sins
- Jesus offered redemption through His blood

Acceptable

Lev. 1:9 | Eph. 5:2

- Burning animal was a soothing aroma
- Jesus' death was a fragrant aroma to God
