

The Will of GoD

G2307 - Will

a *determination* (properly the thing), that is, (actively) *choice* (specifically *purpose*, *decree*; abstractly *volition*)

or

(passively) *inclination:* - desire, pleasure, will

Total KJV occurrences: 64

The Will of God **G2307 -** Will *Two meanings in bible*

1. A sovereign choice or decree – (counsel of His will) Psl 2.7, Eph 1.11, 3.11, ISH 46.10 Paul, an apostle of Christ Jesus by the will of God, and Timothy our brother, (Col 1:1) No one can change it. It is absolute.

The Will of God **G2307** - Will *Two meanings in bible*

Desire or purpose –
you may be filled with the knowledge of his will in all spiritual wisdom and understanding, (Col 1:9)

Gods commands for us to obey.

Scripture urges us to discern the will of god.

Key verses:

(Rom 12:2) Do not be conformed to this world, but be transformed by the renewal of your mind, that by testing you may discern what is the will of God, what is good and acceptable and perfect.

(Eph 5:17) Therefore do not be foolish, but understand what the will of the Lord is.

1. That all men be saved

The Lord is not slow to fulfill his promise as some count slowness, but is patient toward you, not wishing that any should perish, but that all should reach repentance. (2Pe 3:9)

2. Saved souls be controlled by the spirit

Therefore do not be foolish, but understand what the will of the Lord is. ... **be filled with the Spirit**, Eph 5.17-18b

3. we live a holy life

For this is the will of God, your sanctification: (1Th 4:3)

A purposeful and deliberate subjection and obedience to the Spirit in us, to live a life apart from sin in all our daily thoughts and action.

4. We suffer for His sake, patiently

Therefore let those who suffer according to God's will entrust their souls to a faithful Creator while doing good. (1Pe 4:19)

5. We live honorably

For such is the will of God that by **doing right** you may silence the ignorance of foolish men (NASB). (1Pe 2:15)

(in subjection to all human authority)

6. Give thanks in all circumstances

Give thanks in all circumstances; for this is the will of God in Christ Jesus for you. (1Th 5:18)

(Deu 4:5) See, I have taught you statutes and rules, as the LORD my God commanded me, that you should do them in the land that you are entering to take possession of it.

(Deu 4:6) Keep them and do them, for that will be your wisdom and your understanding in the sight of the peoples, who, when they hear all these statutes, will say, 'Surely this great nation is a wise and understanding people.'

What is wisdom and understanding?

(Job 28:12) "But where shall wisdom be found? And where is the place of understanding?

. . .

(Job 28:28) And he said to man, 'Behold, the fear of the Lord, that is wisdom, and to turn away from evil is understanding.'" **Wisdom** is the ability to properly and cohesively bring doctrine into our minds

and

Understanding is to put that wisdom into action.

Where is wisdom found?

(Col 2:3) ... in whom(CHRIST) are hidden all the treasures of wisdom and knowledge.

V10 ... to walk in a manner worthy ...

V10 ... BEARING FRUIT IN EVERY GOOD WORK ...

IN ALL GOOD WORKS (EPH 2.10) EXHIBITING CHRISTIAN LOVE OFFERING PRAISES TO GOD GIVING TIME/MONEY CONDUCT OF THE FRUIT OF THE SPIRT (love, joy, peace, patience, kindness, goodness, faithfulness, gentleness, self-control)

3. That we may grow in knowledge of god

v10 ... increasing in the knowledge of God.

Spiritual growth can only occur with increased intake and understanding of doctrine (knowledge of God and his will)

4. That we may increase in power.

v11 ... be strengthened with all power ...

Power to keep on being a victories steward.

(Eph 3:16) that according to the riches of his glory he may grant you to be strengthened with power through his Spirit in your inner being,

(Eph 3:17) so that Christ may dwell in your hearts through faith--that you, being rooted and grounded in love, ... be filled with the fullness of god (v19)

5. That we endure trials Joyfully.

v11 ... for all endurance and patience with joy ...

Power to keep on being a steadfast and patient steward of God in all courses of life, especially in suffering.

6. That we have a thankful heart.

V12 ... giving thanks to the Father

(Eph 5:20) giving thanks always and for everything to God the Father in the name of our Lord Jesus Christ,

And in all things thankful ...

The results of seeking knowledge of his will. The cycle of action -

Transformed daily conduct (walk/live) Bearing fruit/good works + gal 5.21-22 Produces increased wisdom to do his wilk Generates greater victories in faith Enables joyous endurance in trials Develops a thankful heart Westminster Catechism (a summary of the principles of Christian religion) asks the question:

"What is the chief end of man?"

Answer: "Man's chief end is to glorify God, and to enjoy him forever."

(1Jn 5:20) And we know that the Son of God has come and has given us understanding, so that we may know him who is true; ...

Paul's desire- (Php 3:10) **that I may know him** and the power of his resurrection, and may share his sufferings, becoming like him in his death,

- by steadfast communion with him

Hosea 4:6

"My people are destroyed for lack of knowledge; because you have rejected knowledge..."

"Let us know; let us press on - to know the lord.

His going out is sure as the dawn; he will come to us as the showers, as the spring rains that water the earth." Hosea 6:3
