

### **Common Types of Government**

Monarchy	Rule by one person – king/queen			
Oligarchy	Rule by a few - elite			
Fascism	Rule through values - cultural			
Communism	Rule of the state on behalf of the people			
Socialism	Rule of the state to achieve equity for the people			
Democracy	Rule of the people			
Republic	Indirect rule of the people through representatives			

### God's Plan for Israel – Theocracy

#### Exodus 19:4-6

**4** 'You yourselves have seen what I did to the Egyptians, and how I bore you on eagles' wings, and brought you to Myself.

**5** Now then, if you will indeed obey My voice and keep My covenant, then you shall be My own possession among all the peoples, for all the earth is Mine;

6 and you shall be to Me a kingdom of priests and a holy nation.'...

### Isaiah 44:6

**6** "Thus says the Lord, the King of Israel and his Redeemer, the Lord of hosts: 'I am the first and I am the last, and there is no God besides Me.

# **Reasons for Kings**

#### The People Wanted It

1 Samuel 8:4-5, 20

4 Then all the elders of Israel gathered together and came to Samuel at Ramah;

**5** and they said to him, "Behold, you have grown old, and your sons do not walk in your ways. Now appoint a king for us to judge us like all the nations."

20 that we also may be like all the nations, that our king may judge us and fight our battles."

#### 1 Samuel 8:7

**7** The Lord said to Samuel, "Listen to the voice of the people in regard to all that they say to you, for they have not rejected you, but they have rejected Me from being king over them.


#### **God Planned for It**

### Solomon's Disobedience

### 1 Kings 11:9-13

**9** Now the Lord was angry with Solomon because his heart was turned away from the Lord, the God of Israel, who had appeared to him twice

**10** and had commanded him concerning this thing, that he should not go after other gods; but he did not observe what the Lord had commanded.

**11** So the Lord said to Solomon, "Because you have done this, and you have not kept My covenant and My statutes, which I have commanded you, I will surely tear the kingdom from you, and will give it to your servant

**12** Nevertheless I will not do it in your days for the sake of your father David, but I will tear it out of the hand of your son.

**13** However, I will not tear away all the kingdom, but I will give one tribe to your son for the sake of My servant David and for the sake of Jerusalem which I have chosen."


