The Church, the body of Christ

What does Christ think of the church? (Eph. 5:25-27)

Matt. 16:18 – "....On this rock Lwill build my church, and the gates of hell shall not prevail against it."

<u>Purpose of this study</u> – To understand some of the principles of the New Testament governing the character and conduct of the church.

<u>Note</u>: Correctness of church <u>position</u> must never be separated from correctness of (<u>heart</u>) condition.

Definition of the Church

- Church "ekklesia" (Gk) which means a "called out company", "a gathering", "an assembly". The most common use of the word is a group of believers in the Lord Jesus Christ. Acts 20:28 "the church of God which He purchased with His own blood…."
- The church is not an organization but an organism, a living unit; a fellowship of all who share the life of Christ and linked together in a living Union by the Holy Spirit.
- To further understand the church we will look at various titles used:

Some Titles used for the Church

- A Flock (John 10:16) tended by the Good Shepherd
 - Fold (Gk.aules) an enclosed area (Israel)
 - Flock (Gk.poimne) related to poimen (shepherd)
- God's field (I Cor. 3:9) Fruit bearing
- God's building (I Cor.3:9) (I Pet. 2:5) living stones
- The Temple of God (I Cor.3:16) worship
- The Body of Christ (Eph.1:22-23) Christ's expression
- One New man (Eph.2:15) A new creation

Some Titles used for the Church

- Dwelling place of God (Eph.2:22) Christ in you!
- The Bride of Christ (Eph.5:25-27) Loved by God the Son!
- The House of God (I Tim. 3:15) warmth, security, order, discipline
- The Pillar and ground of the truth (I Tim. 3:15) proclaim, stability, support

When did the church begin?

- Eph.3:4-5 "....the <u>mystery of Christ</u>, which <u>in other ages was not made</u> <u>known</u> to the sons of men, as it <u>has now been revealed</u> by the Spirit to His holy apostles and prophets."
- Eph. 3:9 "...mystery which from the beginning has <u>been hidden in God</u>..." Thus the church was a mystery hidden through Old Testament times and revealed when the New Testament Apostles and prophets appeared.
- Matt. 16:18 Lord Jesus said "on this rock I will build my church..." indicating that it was still a future occurrence when the Lord spoke.
- Eph. 4: 8-11 There is emphasis that the risen Christ will give gifts to the church. We believe and can show that the church began on Pentecost.

When did the church begin?

- I Cor. 12:13 The church was formed by the baptism of the Holy Spirit. When did this happen?
- Acts I:5 The Lord told His disciples ".....you shall be baptized with the Holy Spirit not many days from now."
- Acts 2:1,4 On the day of Pentecost: "And they were all filled with the Holy Spirit....."
- Acts 5:11 "So great fear came upon <u>all the church</u>..." By this time the church has definitely come into being.
